READ (5 mins)

Hebrews 6:1–2 (NKJV)

1 Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary *principles* of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,

2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

RELATE (30 mins)

(Relate to what was shared and on key themes in the sermon)

- **1.** From the first sermon in this series on The Foundation Stones, what is repentance from dead works?
- 2. Today's focus is faith towards God (Heb 6:1). There are 4 Bible verses that says the righteous are to live by faith. Three are in the New Testament which quote from one verse in the Old Testament. Which are these verses? Is this theme on faith linked to the topic of repentance that we've just discussed? If so, in what way?
- 3. With the strong emphasis on living by faith, it is only right we ask the question, "What is faith?" How did the preacher explain what faith is and how do we live by faith in practical terms?

REFLECT (30 mins)

(Reflect and apply God's word to our daily lives)

- 1. In the second part of the sermon, the preacher brought out 8 obstacles of faith. They are human reason, living by sight, surrendering to feelings, negative counsel, feelings of guilt, Satan's tactics, continuing in sin, and neglecting God's Word. Let's focus on the first 4 obstacles. Have you understood how these negatively affect our faith? Share your own example on one of these obstacles.
- 2. Let's look at the next 4 obstacles. Have you understood how these negatively affect our faith? Can we make it worse for ourselves by what we do and by the choices we make?

REST (15 mins)
