READ (5 mins)

(Read the Bible text/s, quietly or aloud)

REFLECT (30 mins)

(Reflect on key themes and questions in the text/s)

- 1. The preacher mentioned the different aspects of God a) Sovereign God, b) Sanctifying God and c) Sending God. Which of the above aspects do you identify most with? Why so? Share with the group.
- 2. Read Isaiah 6:5-7. Isaiah acknowledges that he is sinful like the rest of his people after he saw the King, the Lord of hosts. Are there times when you feel your sins are far too great? Now, knowing that God sanctifies us, how do you feel?
- 3. Read Isaiah 6:1-4. When King Uzziah died, the people of Judah lost their king. Understandably, they would be sad and dismayed. Are there any "kings" sitting on the throne of our hearts, that if we were to lose them, we would end up in despair? What would it take for us to know the True King again?

RELATE (30 min RELATE (30 mins)

(Relate and apply God's word to our daily lives)

- 1. Isaiah felt that he had "unclean lips". Share with the group one area in your life where you would like God to help you speak "clean" and edifying words (e.g. at work, home, school ... give specific examples).
- 2. In the next 2 months, we have many opportunities to invite someone to church end of March, Good Friday weekend, Celebration of Hope. Share with the group the NAME of one person you are hoping to invite. Pray for the persons named.
- 3. Share one thing in your heart that you feel God might be sending you to do, which you have so far avoided or ignored. Let the group pray with you.
