### **READ (5 mins)**

Take the time and read the whole of Nehemiah chapter 5 together in your own bibles.

### **RELATE (30 mins)**

(Relate to what was shared and on key themes in the sermon)

- 1. The first point of the sermon is that to experience a revival there must first be a good leader. Have you seen this principle played out before? Have you played the role of a leader in a certain context to bring about revival?**
- 2. In every experience of spiritual revival, we see God's people becoming more committed to prayer and the reading of God's Word. Something remarkable that we see in Nehemiah is a greater attention to social justice. What does social justice mean to you? In what way did Nehemiah pursue social justice that we can learn from?**

### **REFLECT (30 mins)**

(Reflect and apply God's word to our daily lives)

- 1. Revival begins with you. How did this statement speak to you? Besides learning from Nehemiah's example of pursuing social justice, what else can we learn from him as pointed out in the sermon? And what could have jeopardized Nehemiah's effort?**
- 2. The final point in the sermon is the fear of God must be in our hearts for revival to begin. What is the fear of the Lord and how does it direct us? To what degree do you think you have the fear of God as a disciple of Christ?**

**REST (15 mins)**

(Take time to share and pray for one another)

- Pray for one another to have the desire to be the person to bring revival to our church because revival begins with you.
- Pray for our church to be a people who have a healthy fear of God that will result in us being an obedient people of God's Word.
