#### READ (5 mins)

### REFLECT (30 mins)

(Reflect on key themes and questions in the text/s)

1. Read verses 12-13. What in Moses' bold petition do you think persuaded God to relent and go with him and Israel?

#### Additional notes:

In Exodus 32, the Israelites committed a great sin by worshipping the golden calf, thereby disregarding their covenant with God. They were duly judged for their sin. Because of the golden calf incident, God told Moses that He would send an angel to accompany them to the promised land but He would not go up with them (Exodus 33:2-3).

- 2. Read verse 14. What is the 'rest' that God was referring to in the context of Exodus? (Clue: it is a physical place). What is the ultimate rest God's people can enjoy (cf. Hebrews 4:8-11, Matthew 11:28-30)?
- 3. Read verse 19. God revealed His name as "The LORD" which means "I will be who I will be", followed immediately by: "I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy to whom I will show mercy". What does this tell us about the inclination of God's heart? How is this important for His people who tend to be disobedient?

- Yahweh-Shammah: The LORD is there
- Yahweh-Sabaoth: The LORD of Hosts
