

READ (5 mins)

(Read the Bible text/s, quietly or aloud)

REFLECT (30 mins)

(Reflect on key themes and questions in the text/s)

The reflection questions below are to help us dig deeper into the heart behind enduring as Paul puts it in 2 Timothy 2:12a.

- 1. v. 1-2. What were the two things Paul called Timothy to do? Why was these important? (Read the 2 Timothy 1:8-14 for the context).
- 2. v. 3-7. Paul uses three occupational examples to express his encouragement to Timothy. This shows the emphasis that Paul is trying to make here. How do the three examples show us what enduring means?
- 3. v. 8-13. Paul reiterates what he called Timothy to do in v1-2 and shows that he himself has been living it out (v8-10). He then ends it with a saying to tie all that he has said in this chapter (v11-13). What does this tell us about God and the hope we have if we choose to endure?





(Relate and apply God's word to our daily lives)

- 1. Paul endures because he is personally impacted by the gospel and also knows God's calling for him to preach the gospel for the sake of others. Share, in your group, what are the things that motivates us to endure in our lives.
- 2. Have we considered the gospel in our lives to be the primary motivation for enduring? Share why we do or do not. And from what we have learnt from 2 Timothy 2:1-3, how can we spur one another to endure for the gospel in our lives?
