 - (b) In this context, what was wrong with King Saul's and the people's offering of the "best" to God?
 - (c) According to Samuel, God does not delight in sacrifices as much as He is of our obedience. What does this tells us about the character of God?
- 2. (a) How did David's character stand in contrast to King Saul's? (Ref: 1 Samuel 17: 26, 45, 46)
 - (b) What do we learn about God from this account?

- 1. (a) What are some ways in life where we may fall into the attitude of King Saul?
 - (b) How can we seek to overcome these attitudes?
- 2. (a) Are there "giants" in our lives that we have allowed to grow larger than God? Why would these "giants" be detrimental to our spiritual well-being?
 - (b) In such situations, how can we apply "David-like" attitudes? Have we paused to allow the power of God to work in our lives before the "giant" does?
