REFLECT (30 mins)

- 2. If I sin, do I lose my righteousness? Refer to Ps Jon's illustration of the piece of gold. (Process of discipleship/sanctification, repenting process leading to Christian perfection)

3. Discuss the difference between being remorseful and showing true repentance. (Refer to Romans 12: 2 and Ecclesiastes 3: 11)

4. Read Jeremiah 29: 12-14 and describe the heart of God in these verses.

RELATE (30 mins)

(Relate and apply God's word to our daily lives)
