<u>READ (5 mins)</u> (Read the Bible text, quietly or aloud)

REFLECT (30 mins)

(Reflect on key themes and questions in the text)

- 1. Is it possible for the pride we have in our country to turn into arrogance? What is so dangerous about the kind of pride warned about in Scripture? (See Psalm 127:1 and Proverbs 29:23)
- 2. Ms. Lim said, "We as Singaporean Christians have the authority and the responsibility to pray for this land." According to Scripture, how are we to pray for Singapore? (See 1 Peter 2:17; 1 Timothy 2:1 2)
- **3.** "Speak life," our speaker encouraged. In your understanding, how do we do this? (See Psalm 109:17; 1 Peter 3:8 9)

4. Was there a time when you took God's favour for granted? What led to it or how did that happen?

RELATE (30 mins)

(Relate and apply God's word to our daily lives)



- 1. We are so quick to blame and judge others. How would you like to respond if the MRT system breaks down, an elevator breaks down, or something goes wrong that you are not responsible for and it inconveniences you?
- 2. Did you identify with the preacher when she shared how she needed to "get our own house in order" in the example of her family being attacked by dengue? Share one example of your own.

REST (15 mins)

- Pray for one another to have a prayerful and humble heart, one that is constantly looking to God for His favour and one that is quick to bless and not to blame.
