READ (5 mins)

Read Acts 10:1 – 48 together on your own bibles.

RELATE (30 mins)

(Relate to what was shared and on key themes in the sermon)

- 1. In the Bible passage for today we read of an angel appearing to a man to give him a message from God. The preacher said that our God is a personable God and He speaks to us today. He wants to speak to each one of us, His children. Can we expect God to speak to us personally and directly today? What about sending an angel to us?**
- 2. God's unmistakable timing and truth compels us to put aside our assumptions and surrender to His leading. What are some assumptions we have about the way God leads us? Does God always lead to go to places and do things we prefer not to?**

REFLECT (30 mins)

(Reflect and apply God's word to our daily lives)

- 1. A very important point in the sermon is God's truth changes us. How have you been changed by God's truth in the past 2 or 3 years? Share one heart or mind change you have experienced lately.**
- 2. When we encounter God's voice or truth, our response matters as much as our readiness to accept that truth. Firstly, we respond by proclaiming God's truth. Secondly, we connect God's truth to our lives. Have you responded to God's truth in one of these ways? Have you responded in other ways?**

REST (15 mins)

(Take time to share and pray for one another)

(Pray for our church, our nation, and our world. See MyPMC > PRAY for monthly guide)

- Pray for one another to have the humility to allow God's truth to change us.
- Pray for our church to understand God's time for us as a church, to respond to God's truth with a right heart, not calling common that which is holy to God and that whom God has made holy.
- Pray for the MCS to continue to be strong and stable, able to meet needs in Singapore, and stand out as a true witness of Christ Jesus.
