READ (5 mins)

John 4:20-24 (ESV)

20 Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, but you say that in Jerusalem is the place where people ought to worship."

21 Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe me, the hour is coming when neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father.

22 You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews.

23 But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him.

24 God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth."

RELATE (30 mins)

REFLECT (30 mins)

- 1. Jesus said those who worship God must worship in spirit. What does it mean to worship in spirit and how do we get to the point of worshipping in spirit? Furthermore, how can we tell if we are truly worshipping God in spirit?
- 2. Worshipping in the spirit is also worshiping in truth. Why is truth important in the worship of God?
