THE SUBSTANCE OF PRAYER: FAITH

"Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours."

- Whatever seems humanly impossible is made possible through praying in faith.
- Faith is trusting in Jesus and perseveres in the midst of doubts.
- Faith is <u>really believing</u> what God says in His Word – and this often involves action and risk-taking.



THE LOGIC OF PRAYER?

THE LOGIC OF PRAYER

Theology:

- "Prayer has one function, and that is to answer 'Yes', when He knocks, to open the soul and give Him the opportunity to bring us the answer."
- e.g. waiting, fasting "to induce us to open our hearts ... to put away all those things which would distract us and prevent us from hearing Jesus knock, that is, from hearing the Spirit of prayer when He tries to tell us what God is waiting to give us if we will only ask for it."

(O Hallesby, "Prayer")
