"Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

A title reserved for the expected Jewish Messiah

"When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and <u>healed their sick</u>." (Matthew 14:14)

What is your view of God?



Jesus asked Bartimaeus, "What do you want me to do for you?"

Bartimaeus' reply, **"Lord, I want to see."**

Act of faith

What is Faith?

"We walk by faith, not by sight." (2 Corinthians 5:7)

What is Faith?

Faith sees the invisible kingdom of God.

Saith in action makes visible the invisible kingdom of God.

"Faith was never intended only to get us into the family. Rather, it is the nature of life in this family. Faith sees. It brings His Kingdom into focus. All of the Father's resources, all of His benefits, are accessible through faith." (Bill Johnson)
