Sovereignty of God

Psalm 115:3

"Our God is in the heavens; he does all that he pleases."

Job 42:2

"I know that you can do all things, and that no purpose of yours can be thwarted."

Our future is dependent on the plans we make

Proverbs 21:5

The plans of the diligent lead surely to abundance, but everyone who is hasty comes only to poverty.

Proverbs 20:18

Plans are established by counsel; by wise guidance wage war.

Human Responsibility

- It is important to plan.
- Be diligent about it.
- Get good advice.
- If you plan well, you get to enjoy the benefits.

Tension

Our future is dependent on God (Sovereignty of God)

Our future is dependent on the plans we make
(Human Responsibility)

It is NOT "Either... Or..."

 God is able to accomplish His plans through your plans.

You are responsible for your choices.
 But God is in charge of your future.

How can we hold the two together?

Some unhelpful approaches:

- You do your best and God will do the rest.
- God helps those who help themselves.
- What is God's perfect plan for my life?

"Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and your plans will succeed."
(Proverbs 16:3)

Summary

Your plans matter, but what matters even more than your plans is that you are fully committed to God, because God is sovereign.

Personal Commitment to God

 It is a commitment to <u>God Himself</u>; not what you can do for God.

• It is also a commitment to <u>follow Him</u> wherever He leads us – God is calling us on an adventure with Him.
