i.e. why they kept trying to say Jesus was breaking the Laws to disqualify His claim as Messiah. But the Bible records these were false accusations.

BOTH ARE RIGHT – JUST DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES




TEST IT

- ➤ The Word became Flesh (Jn 1:14; **Eze 36:26-27**; Eze 11:19-20)
- The Law must be written on our hearts (Jer 31:31-34)
- ➤So if Jesus is the Word Who became Flesh and we say we accept Him as Lord, then shouldn't His Law become written upon our hearts? (Eph 3:17)
- ➤ As with all Law God's Law requires obedience not out of compulsion but love. (1 John 2:4-8)
- The Word became Flesh to turn our stony hearts to hearts of flesh.

Paul is a Messianic Jewish Rabbi who paints pictures with his words. So we will use the following characters to get an idea of what he is talking about it Romans 6-8:

ILLUSTRATION:

THE CHARACTERS: THE FARMER, THE PLOUGH, THE YOKE, STRONG OX THAT LEADS ANOTHER OX, THE PATH



We were yoked to the sinful nature and it is stronger than us. The plough of the Law's regulations will go off the mark in our hearts and this is SIN 'the breaking of the Law' Sin will yield Death


The Law is good and knows what is right but it is powerless to help us

THIS IS THE SUMMARY OF ROMANS 6-7

Please note that Romans 8:2 indicates that Paul is talking about two different Laws – one is God's Law and it is good. The other is the law of sin and death that Christ destroyed.

Christ My Master





The Spirit of Truth proceeds from Him and leads us to all Truth. He guides us as the Stronger One.

As we Obey His Leading, Life results – Spirit Life!

The Law now serves Christ, it will not go wrong for it is perfect – it is the plough that holds our yoke to Him so we can walk as He does! Further we have a new heart.


Who is Greater –

THIS IS THE SUMMARY OF ROMANS 8 (cf Matt 11:28-30)

Put to death my flesh

Got yoked to the Spirit of Grace

Accepted Christ as Master




That kept me from walking the straight path of the Perfect Law The stony heart is removed

That empowered me to walk the straight path of the Perfect Law The heart of flesh is given



THIS IS WHAT HAPPENED AT OUR JUSTIFICATION



THIS IS WHAT HAPPENED AT OUR JUSTIFICATION
THAT WE MAY WALK AS JESUS WALKED = SANCTIFICATION

- † What shall we say then?
 - Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound? By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it?
- + What then?
 - Are we to sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means! Do you not know ... you are slaves of anyone whom you obey?

RED: **STOP** MAKING **EXCUSES FOR SIN**

- † What then shall we say?
 - That the Law is sin? By no means! Yet if it had not been for the Law I should not have known sin.
- † The Law is holy... just and good.
 - Did that which is good then bring death to me? By no means! It was sin working death in me...

AMBER: TAKE TIME TO **CHANGE WRONG PERCEPTIONS** OF GOD'S LAW

- † There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus has set me free from the Law of sin and death...
- † ...Those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit.
- † For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's Law, indeed it cannot.

GREEN: GO **FORWARD IN** OBEDIENCE, **EMPOWERED** BY GRACE

- † The Spirit helps us in our weakness, interceding for us.
- † God's will for us is to be conformed into the likeness of His Son.
- † What then shall we say? If God is for us, who is against us? Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?

STAY FOCUSSED ON **BECOMING** LIKE CHRIST TO SILENCE THE FLESH

REMEMBER

- + God's Law isn't legalism!
- † Law without Grace = Legalism
- † Grace without Law = Liberalism.
- † The best Gospel preached is the Gospel lived out.

CONCLUSION

- † All creation is waiting for the revelation of God's children (Romans 8:18-25)
- 1 Cor 15:35-44; Matt 13:39-43; Daniel 12:2-3. The time is coming when how we have lived our lives will become either painfully or gloriously obvious to all. Will we be found as stars shining to full capacity?
