

- 1. Couples those who were married for 20 years or longer (20 per cent)


Younger Couples Ending Faster SOURCE: MSF



CONTEXT: FATHER'S POWER: PATRIA POTESTA

"Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord." (Eph 6: 3)

Absolute Power: Sell as slaves, work in fields in chains, punish as he likes, even inflict death penalty.

Roman son never come of age: A son always a son.

Son born placed at Father's feet: Receive – part of family. If not – thrown away. Sickly or deformed child.

CONTEXT: FATHER'S POWER = PATRIA POTESTA

"We slaughter a fierce ox: we strangle a mad dog; we plunge the knife into sickly catle lest they taint the herd; children who are born weakly and deformed, we drown." Seneca

Exasperate: "Goad our children to resentment" Col 3: 1: do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged."



#1 Marriage relationship is foundational for healthy parent-child relationship

* Healthy Marital relationship is key to strong parent-child relationship. (Jn 13: 34, 35)

"This is a profound mystery—but I am talking about Christ and the church. However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband." (Eph 5: 32, 33)



If you want to lead out of your marriage, then you must make marriage not leadership your first ambition, your first passion, and your loudest gospel message.

We must cultivate a strong desire to make visible the invisible the love of Jesus for his church in and through the love we have for our spouse. We then lead out of the overflow of this love.

In other words, out of the giving and receiving of the connection in our relationship, we have an extra 'give away' love. It overflows from the nurturing, connection, and sense of well-being we receive from one another.

Day and night we wonder how to give ourselves to our future spouse. We are sexually attracted to him or her. We are drawn out of our selfishness into an other-centered focus.

How to provoke your child to anger?

- Exaggeration & Magnification
- Scapegoating & Nit-picking
- •Focus on negatives & Parade of the horribles: Imagination of the worst possible
- Harsh start-ups & Personal attack

Appropriate Discipline & Generous Affirmation

"Spare the rod and spoil the child – that is true; but beside the rod keep an apple to give him when he has done well."

In all societies and every culture, this is the right duty.

#2 Honoring parents is based on fundamentals

Fundamental #2. Biblical norm with a promise "Honor your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise— **3** "so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth."

- •Reverence for parents is part of reverence for God (Exo 20: 12; Lv 19: 1-3
- The promise: A healthy parent-child is pre-requisite of a healthy community.
