Judge Not

Judge not, that you be not judged. For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged

Matthew 7:1-2a NKJV

Don't pick on people, jump on their failures, and criticize their faults— unless, of course, you want the same treatment.

THE MESSAGE

Do not condemn or negatively criticize Christians who have different convictions from us, particularly in things that the Bible does not specifically command or forbid.

διαλογισμῶν [dialogismon]

- disputable matters
- personal opinions
- doubtful matters
- reasonings
- speculations
- motives

Accept the one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters. (Romans 14:1)

(διαλογισμῶν)

Adiaphora

- matters of indifference
- customs and traditions or secondary beliefs that are not crucial to the Gospel
- Bible does not specifically command or forbid

Adiaphora

- Dietary preferences (Rom 14:2)
- Observance of special days (Rom 14:5)

- 1. Do not be addicted to it. Stop and ponder regularly as you play.
- 2. You might also have an open door to the spiritual world if you have dabbled with the occult before and have been oppressed.
- 3. Be alert to the Lord's leading.
- 4. Be aware of the worldview and values you might embrace.
- 5. Please DO NOT play the game in Church. Let us honor God's presence in this holy place.

6. As you are probably aware, different churches and pastors hold different positions. It varies from great openness to abject rejection.

Keep three principles in mind:

- Do not bear false witness against the game and one another.
- Do not be easily frightened when you encounter imaginative genres in literature or games.
- Guard the unity of the spirit. Avoid the spirit of condemnation and judgementalism.

Negative criticism never helps!

Accept the one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters. Rom 14:1 NIV

Receive one who is weak in the faith, but not to dispute over doubtful things. NKJV

Welcome those who are weak in faith, but do not argue with them about their personal opinions. GNB

Welcome with open arms fellow believers who don't see things the way you do. And don't jump on them every time they do or say something you don't agree with—even when it seems that they are strong on opinions but weak in the faith department. Remember, they have their own history to deal with. Treat them gently. THE MESSAGE

So where does that leave you when you criticize a brother? And where does that leave you when you condescend to a sister? I'd say it leaves you looking pretty silly—or worse. Eventually, we're all going to end up kneeling side by side in the place of judgment, facing God. Your critical and condescending ways will not improve your position one bit.

Read it for yourself in Scripture:

"As I live and breathe," God says, every knee will bow before me; Every tongue will tell the honest truth that I and only I am God."

So tend to your knitting. You've got your hands full just taking care of your own life before God.
