10 And again he (Moses, Deut 32) says:

11 And again (**David**?, Ps 117):

"Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles!

Laud Him, all you peoples!"

12 And again, **Isaiah** (Is 11) says: "There shall be a root of Jesse; and He who shall rise to reign over the Gentiles,

in Him the Gentiles shall hope."

Matthew 28:18-19
