




### See The Present in Light of the Future Promised by God





#### 1) The Future Brings Assured Hope







For we do not want you to be unaware, brothers, of the affliction we experienced in Asia. For we were so utterly burdened beyond our strength that we despaired of life itself. Indeed, we felt that we had received the sentence of death. But that was to make us rely not on ourselves but on God who raises the dead. He delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us. On him we have set our hope that he will deliver us again. (2 Cor 1:8-10)





## He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the Spirit as a guarantee (2 Cor 5:5)



## Implications 1) Guarantee of resurrected life is in us: inward renewal until death is swallowed up by life






## Implications 2) Our groaning is hopeful/not meaningless

For in this tent we groan, longing to put on our heavenly dwelling...For while we are still in this tent, we groan, being burdened—not that we would be unclothed, but that we would be further clothed, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life (2 Cor 5:2, 4)



## 3) Considering the Future Hope, Walk by Faith





So we are always of good courage. We know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord...Yes, we are of good courage, and we would rather be away from the body and at home with the Lord. (2 Cor 5:6, 8)
