He said to them, **Say “NO”** desires to follow Me, let him **deny** himself, and **take up his cross**, and **follow** Me.



Philippians 2:5-8

... Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, **did not consider** equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he **made himself nothing** by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming **obedient to death** — even death on a cross!



- † Denying, or always giving in?
- † Taking up cross, or avoiding it?
- † Have I faced any hardship the last 6 months, because I am a Christian?
- † Have I *lost* anything lately, because of the Gospel?

2. Is my soul saved?

† What is my greatest desire in life?
Is it to love God and do His will, or is it to pursue worldly gods of *possessions, popularity, power, pleasure?*

† If God takes away my job, my house, my life savings tomorrow, will I still *worship Him?*

† If God allows my health to fail terribly, will I still *follow Christ?*

3. Am I ashamed of Jesus?

- † Do I consider suffering for Christ a privilege or a shame?
- † Is my relationship with Jesus more important than all other relationships?
- † Am I willing to tell others about Jesus at the *risk of ridicule, rejection and persecution*?
- † Will I unashamedly invite people for PMC's Christmas Outreach?



REFLECTION

Summary – “To be a Christian”

- † Follow Christ, be willing to suffer worldly loss, personal pain and social embarrassment**
- † Give up (lose!) everything for sake of Gospel**
- † Be unashamed of Christ’s suffering.**
