- ✓ Χάρις, (charis) – *to show kindness to someone, with the implication of graciousness on the part of the one showing such kindness* (L&N, 88.66)
- ✓ A beneficial disposition toward someone (BDAG)

# Grace

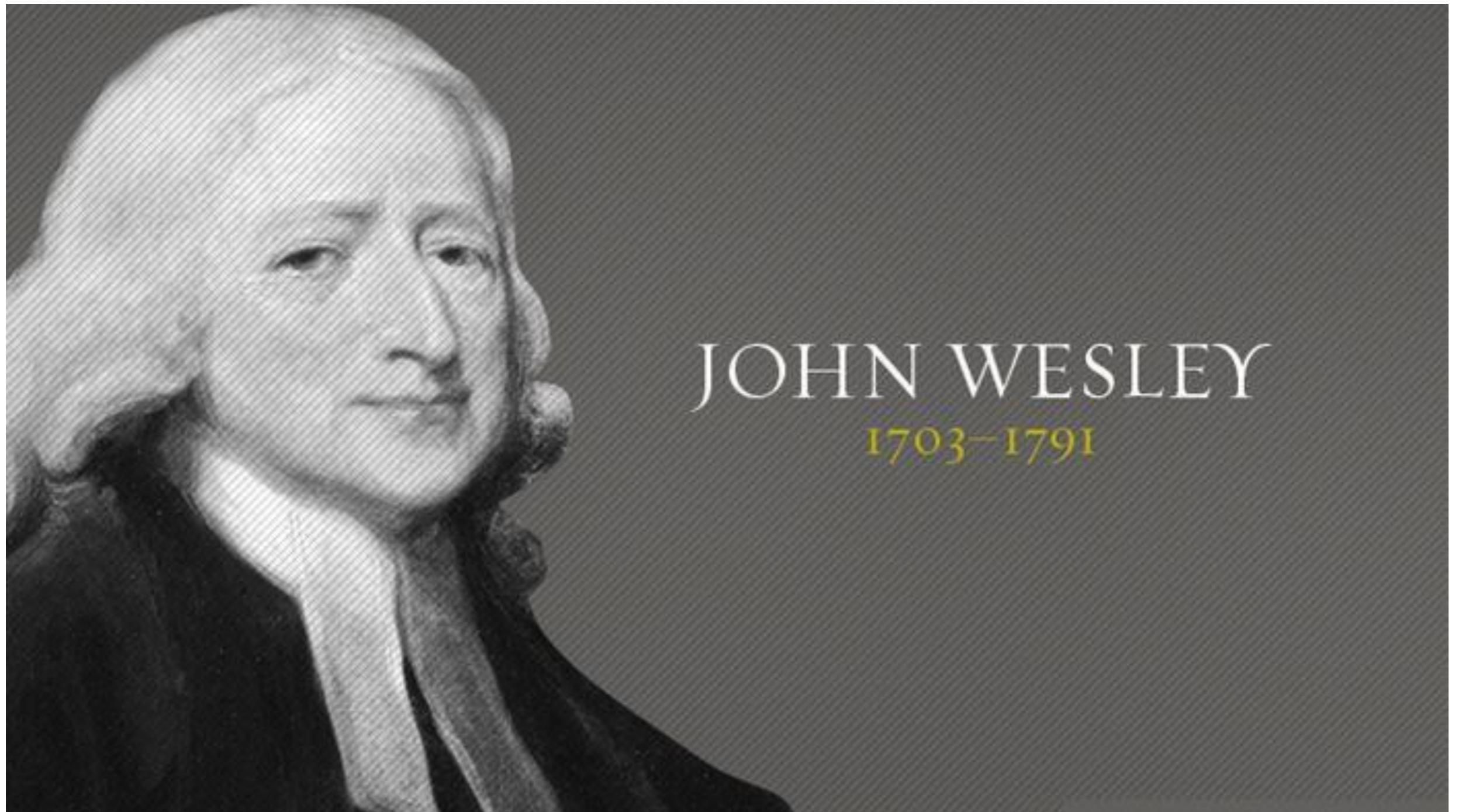
(Grâce) noun;

1. The exercise of love, kindness, or good will; disposition to benefit or serve another.
2. The divine favor toward man; the undeserved kindness or forgiveness of God; divine love or pardon.
3. Beauty, physical, intellectual, or moral; easy elegance of manners; perfection of form.

## Grace

[ˈgrās] - noun

def: the act of freely providing spiritual blessings to sinners who do not deserve them



God's "bounty (*goodness/generosity*), or favour (*kindness*): his free, undeserved favour, ... man having no claim to the least of his mercies. It was free grace that 'formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into him a living soul,' and stamped on that soul the image of God, and 'put all things under his feet.' ... For there is nothing we are, or have, or do, which can deserve the least thing at God's hand."






**who gave himself (*Jesus*) for


# GRACE IS RADICAL...
