- A beneficial disposition toward someone (BDAG)


# Grace

### Grace


[ˈgrās] - noun

def: the act of freely providing spiritual blessings to sinners who do not deserve them



God's "bounty (goodness/generosity), or favour (kindness): his free, undeserved favour, ... man having no claim to the least of his mercies. It was free grace that 'formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into him a living soul,' and stamped on that soul the image of God, and 'put all things under his feet.' ... For there is nothing we are, or have, or do, which can deserve the least thing at God's hand."


