


ACTS 1:4-8





## The Holy Spirit came...


... the Presence of the Lord was now in His people and upon His people...

We read of revivals - what He has done elsewhere, He can do in our midst!








The Holy Spirit comes in His Fullness



# IS THIS FOR THE METHODIST CHURCH?

Wesley and the early Methodists move in the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Wesley defended the move of the Holy Spirit and he wrote a treatise affirming that the gifts of the Holy Spirit still exist today.



Mon. Jan. 1, 1739 – Mr. Hall, Kinchin, Ingham, Whitefield, Hutchins, and my brother Charles, were present at out lovefeast in Fetter Lane, with about sixty of our brethren.

About three in the morning, as we were continuing instant in prayer, the power of God came mightily upon us, insomuch that many cried our for exceeding joy, and many fell to the ground.

As soon as we were recovered a little from that awe and amazement at the presence of his Majesty, we broke out with one voice, 'We praise thee, O God; we acknowledge thee to be the Lord.'
