





THE RAPTURE Caught up - harpazo ἀρπάζω


- A shout the voice of an archangel

- Those living in Christ will be caught up













The Pre-Tribulation Rapture




The Mid-Tribulation Rapture





The Pre-Wrath Rapture




The Post-Tribulation Rapture

The Partial Rapture






Rapture - when?
