## Philippians 3:20-21

• For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His **glorious body**, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

#### 2 Cor 3:18

• And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.

## Luke 24:37-42

• 37 They were startled and frightened, thinking they saw a ghost. 38 He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts rise in your minds? 39 Look at my hands and my feet. It is I myself! Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have."

## Luke 24:37-42

• 40 When he had said this, he showed them his hands and feet. 41 And while they still did not believe it because of joy and amazement, he asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" 42 They gave him a piece of broiled fish, 43 and he took it and ate it in their presence.

## 1 Kings 18:44 - 45

- So Elijah said, "Go and tell Ahab, 'Hitch up your chariot and go down before the rain stops you."
- 45 Meanwhile, the sky grew black with clouds, the wind rose, a heavy rain started falling and Ahab rode off to Jezreel. 46 The power of the Lord came on Elijah and, tucking his cloak into his belt, he ran ahead of Ahab all the way to Jezreel.

## Gen 22:1

2 Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love—Isaac—and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you."

## God will provide **Himself**

- Abraham answered, "<u>God himself will provide</u> the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." And the two of them went on together. NIV
- Abraham said, "<u>God will provide for himself</u> the lamb for a burnt offering, my son." So they went both of them together. (ESV)
- And Abraham said, My son, <u>God will provide</u> <u>himself</u> a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together. (KJV)

## Hebrews 11:19

 Abraham reasoned that if Isaac died, God was able to bring him back to life again. And in a sense, Abraham did receive his son back from the dead.

#### Acts 2:27-32

#### Acts 2:27-32

29 "Dear brothers, think about this! You can be sure that the patriarch David wasn't referring to himself, for he died and was buried, and his tomb is still here among us. 30 But he was a prophet, and he knew God had promised with an oath that one of David's own descendants would sit on his throne.

#### Acts 2:27-32

31 David was looking into the future and speaking of the Messiah's resurrection. He was saying that God would not leave him among the dead or allow his body to rot in the grave.


#### Romans 10:9
